RESOLUTION NO 24-265**

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING A SOLE SOURCE PURCHASE RELATING TO
REPAIR OF MINE RESISTANT AMBUSH PROTECTED (MRAP) VEHICLE,
WAIVING THE PROCUREMENT REQUIREMENTS PURSUANT TO PAGE 51
OF THE CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT POLICIES**

WHEREAS, the Liberty Lake Police Department (“LLPD”) acquired a mine-resistant ambush protected (MRAP) vehicle through the U.S Department of State’s Law Enforcement Officers Safety Act (LEOSA) vehicle loan program at no cost; and

WHEREAS, upon acquisition of the vehicle, it was determined that certain repairs were necessary to make the vehicle operational; and

WHEREAS, SWATMOD, LLC is only one known entity that specializes in maintenance and repair of MRAP vehicles in the nation; and

WHEREAS, SWATMOD, LLC was in Spokane on September 14, 2024, working on another vehicle and Police Chief Damon Simmons was able to schedule this repair on short notice, saving mobilization costs; and

WHEREAS, the LLPD has a Police Capital Fund that has been the beneficiary of generous private annual donations for the express benefit of LLPD operations, of which the cost of this repair will be debited from; and


WHEREAS, Page 51 of the City of Liberty Lake Financial Management Policies states that procurement requirements may be waived upon approval of a Resolution of the City declaring that the purchase is clearly and legitimately limited to a single source or supply; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that a sole source purchase did exist and that it is appropriate to waive the aforementioned procurement requirements in relation to this repair.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake does hereby adopt the following:


Pursuant to page 51 of the City of Liberty Lake Financial Management Policies, a Sole Source Purchase exists for the above stated reasons to waive procurement requirements and approve the payment for the repairs to the LLPD MRAP vehicle in the amount of \$10,596.00 plus any applicable taxes.

PASSED by the City Council this 1st day of October, 2024.




