OFFICERS.**


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE, THAT:

Pursuant to the provisions of RCW 35.21.770 and 35A.11.110, members of the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington are hereby authorized to serve as volunteer members of the local fire or police Departments, and to receive the same compensation, insurance, and other benefits applicable to other volunteer firefighters, ambulance personnel, or reserve law enforcement officers employed by the City.
