**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LIBERTY LAKE, WASHINGTON DESIGNATING
THE OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER.**

WHEREAS, the Liberty Lake City Council is required pursuant to RCW 35A.21.230 to designate an official newspaper of the City having the qualifications prescribed by RCW 65.16 for the purpose of publishing notices, Ordinances (or summaries thereof) and other matters relating to the business of the City;

WHEREAS, the City on November 9, 2011 published a request for newspaper services setting forth the requirements of the City, the fee proposal to be delivered to the City, and the time for submission of the proposal to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has received proposals for newspaper services and is desirous of designating an official newspaper of the City of Liberty Lake.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Resolved by the City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, Washington as follows:

1. Official Newspaper.

The City of Liberty Lake, Washington through its City Council designates The Splash as the official newspaper of the City of Liberty Lake. The City shall submit to the newspaper its legal notices, Ordinances (or summaries thereof) and other matters which shall be published pursuant to state law. The newspaper, after publication, shall provide an affidavit to the City setting forth the text and date of publication.

2. Effective Date.


This Resolution shall take effect January 1, 2012.


